

Q: Is the property disabled accessible.

A: All buildings are accessible and there are paved flat paths between all the buildings. There are a limited number of accessible rooms that can accommodate wheelchairs. Contact boise@jnanasukha.org prior to registering for availability.

Q: Is there transportation provided to and from retreat center.

Q: Can I camp on site?

A: Camping on site in tent or trailer is not permitted.

Q: Is anyone driving from the airport or California or "insert name of your city or location here" so that I can share a ride?

Q: Can I pay for an extra day (or two) at the retreat center before (or after) the program.

A: No. Accommodation options are for the Full or Weekend program. If you must arrive early or leave after the program dates, you will need to arrange for accommodations elsewhere.

Q: How early can I arrive at the retreat center on Friday?

A: We have access to the retreat center property at 4:30 pm. There is no access to the facilities before this time. Please plan your arrival time accordingly.

Q: How late can I arrive on Friday Night?

A: If you are arriving after 9pm and are staying in a private room or you and your room mate are arriving late, we can make arrangements for you to pick up a key for your room. We cannot accommodate late arrivals for anyone sharing a room with an assigned room mate.

Q: I have my Ngondro text and commentary from previous retreats, do I need to purchase a new one?

A: No, you do not need to purchase a new one if you have a copy already. Everyone registered for the full retreat will receive a new copy of the texts and commentary at the retreat. Those attending the weekend and daily programs may purchase a copy of the text at a discounted rate if they do not have one. If you do not want to purchase a text be aware that we are not providing loaners for the practice sessions. There will be enough people with texts that it be easy to share during practice.

Q: Do I need to bring my own zafu and zabutan.

A: The floor is carpeted, but you will want to bring your own cushion or blanket to sit on. Chairs are available for those who are more comfortable sitting in a chair.

Q: Do I need to bring my own linens and towels?

A: The accommodations include bedding and towels. If you have any special needs with regard to these items, please feel free to bring your own.

Q: Are offerings to the teachers included in the tuition.

A: We do not include an offering or dana in the tuition. You may make your own offering to them during them and the translator at the retreat if you wish.
